Purpose

The AIB Dean's Merit List and Valedictorian Award recognises students for outstanding academic performance by MBA coursework students in each calendar year of study.

Scope

This policy applies to the MBA graduand list who have completed the relevant Course requirements since the cut-off date for the prior AIB Graduation ceremony in Australia.

The Dean's Merit List and Valedictorian Award will:

- recognise outstanding academic achievement,
- be allocated on the basis of a clear set of criteria,
- be awarded on the basis of academic merit and ethical conduct, and
- be conducted through a transparent selection process.
