

# **Dean's Merit List and Valedictorian Award Policy**

## **Purpose**

The AIB Dean's Merit List and Valedictorian Award recognises outstanding academic performance by MBA coursework students in each calendar year of study. Dean's Merit List students and the Valedictorian will be acknowledged at the Graduation ceremony and will also be published on the AIB website after the ceremony.

#### Scope

This policy applies to the MBA graduand list who have completed the relevant Course requirements since the cut-off date for the prior AIB Graduation ceremony in Australia.

#### **Definitions**

Unless otherwise defined in this document, all capitalised terms are defined in the glossary.

### **Policy**

#### 1. Principles

The Dean's Merit List and Valedictorian Award will:

- recognise outstanding academic achievement,
- be allocated on the basis of a clear set of criteria,
- be awarded on the basis of academic merit and ethical conduct, and
- be conducted through a transparent selection process.
