

COVID-19 Relief Scholarship - Terms and Conditions

Eligibility

The AIB COVID-19 Relief Scholarship is available for new students applying to the following AIB courses:

- Graduate Certificate in Management; or
- Master of Business Administration; or
- Master of Management.

Students must be Australian citizens or residents at the time of application and had their livelihood significantly impacted by COVID-19.

To be eligible, you must have met AIB course entry requirements and: (1) Been made redundant, terminated or stood down from your permanent full time, part time or fixed term job; OR (2) Had your average monthly income from a permanent full time, part time or fixed term or casual job reduced by 30%+; OR (3) Had the business you operate as a sole trader, small business owner suffer 30% reduction in average monthly revenue; AND (4) Had those things occur as a result of COVID 19 or mandated social distancing.

Scholarship details

Funding for two of your first three subjects (Subjects 1 and 3) will be provided through the COVID-19 Relief Scholarship.

The scholarship subjects must be undertaken no later than Term 2 2021.

This Scholarship can be accessed for Subjects 1 and 3, where Subject 1 is the first attempt of Leadership (8001LEAD) and Subject 3 is the first attempt of either Strategic Human Resource Management (8003SHRM) or Operations Management (8004OMGT) as recommended subjects; however, another subject can be studied in lieu of 8003SHRM or 8004OMGT. In the case of unsuccessful first attempt, further attempts will need to be funded by alternative methods.

If you are unable to complete either Subject 1 or Subject 3 due to significant medical/compassionate (MC) reasons, an MC grade may be applied. Standard MC process will apply in line with the AIB [Withdrawal and Deferral Policy and Procedure](#).

Scholarship recipients are not able to study the subjects for which the Scholarship is provided concurrently with any subjects funded by FEE-HELP.

AIB reserves the right to cap the number of available COVID-19 Relief Scholarship places in a term due to operational teaching capacity, however this will not reduce the total number of scholarships available or the total value of the scholarship pool.

How to apply?

Applicants must supply evidence of the impact of COVID-19 on their income. Evidence required:

- Employees:
 - letter from employer confirming:
 - stand down; OR
 - reduced hours by at least 30%; OR
 - reduced pay by at least 30%; OR
 - termination of employment; OR
 - payslip showing at least 30% reduction in wages; OR;
- Business Owners and Self Employed:
 - financial statement showing decline in revenue of at least 30% (compared to last year, or the previous 3 months); OR
 - evidence of cancellation of at least 30% of future bookings.
