

AS YOU APPROACH THE END OF YOUR MBA, YOUR THOUGHTS WILL BE TURNING TOWARDS YOUR FINAL PROJECT. THIS FLYER OUTLINES THE STRUCTURE OF THIS SUBJECT AND THE SUPPORT AIB PROVIDES TO HELP YOU SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETE YOUR STUDIES.

- → Your project will take 7 weeks from start-to-finish and will be delivered in an online class environment with online facilitator guidance throughout.
- You will be provided with an example list of project topics on the subject page, to get you underway and to guide your approach. You will have an opportunity to customise your project to your own organisation (or industry).
- You will use secondary data (publicly available data) only (i.e. no primary data is permitted, no data collection through interviews or surveys).
- You will be closely supported by your online facilitator. You are encouraged to regularly participate on the class forums and weekly webinars. Submit your optional (brief) status updates to make your online facilitator aware of your progress and raise any difficulties you may have.
- → The submission of the final report is due at the end of the subject
- → You will be assessed in the form of a brief project statement (500 words) and two scaffolded assessment items: A draft literature review and methodology section and a final report (4,500 words).
- → You do not need a textbook. Your learning resources will include targeted readings which scaffold your learning and direct your attention to key areas. Your subject resources are tailored to support each step in the MBA Project process.
