


Evaluating your search results

Researching is an organic process. As your knowledge and understanding develop, you may find you need to adapt your plan to reflect the information and evidence you have found.

Generally, find the answers to the simplest questions first (definitions, descriptions, models and basic explanations). Then move on to find answers and evidence for the more complex questions - investigate key theories, models, arguments and writers.

Here are 3 common search problems that you will no doubt encounter and some tips to help you troubleshoot them.

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Click on the **cited by 4** to see the related articles. Again, read the abstract to determine if the article is relevant to your commentary.
