Among 83 participating institutions, an impressive 92.4% of AIB graduates rated their postgraduate Business & Management experience positively, significantly surpassing the national average of 82.6%.*

When compared to the satisfaction of postgraduates from business and management courses at other universities and non-university higher education institutions, AIB's results significantly exceeded the national average, setting a new benchmark for postgraduate business education.

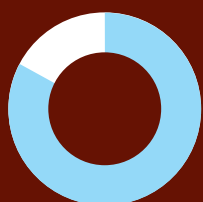

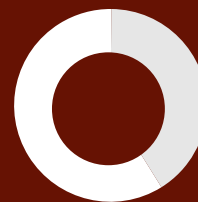

Entry Requirements

A MINIMUM OF FIVE YEARS OF RELEVANT WORK EXPERIENCE

Which includes at least three years of management experience or significant technical experience.

OR

A BACHELOR'S DEGREE +2YRS

(AQF Level 7) and at least two years of relevant work experience.

OR

AN ADVANCED DIPLOMA ASSOCIATE DEGREE +3YRS

(AQF Level 6) or learning equivalent to an AQF Level 6 qualification and at least three years of relevant work experience.

OR

MINIMUM GMAT SCORE OF 550

Graduate Management Admission Test (GMAT) with a minimum score of 550 and at least three years of relevant work experience.

Recognition of prior learning

If you currently hold a qualification in a business-related field, you could use AIB's Credit Transfer policy to recognise your prior achievement, helping you earn an MBA faster, for less.

English requirements

Our program is conducted entirely in English, and all candidates must meet AIB's English proficiency requirements, irrespective of their location. In areas or nations with more than one official
